Students need to wear warm comfortable clothing that can get dirty, (tennis shoes or hiking boots), and they need to bring coats, hats and gloves. They also need to bring a disposable sack lunch with drinks.



## Class Parties Scheduled-Dec.16th

K-5 through 8th grades will have their class parties from 8:00-9:30 am. (A teacher will send a note home regarding the individual parties).

After the parties, we will leave for the Skatehouse, and skate from 10:00-12:00 pm. Students admission cost is covered by the field trip fee. **PAR-ENTS ARE WELCOME TO COME AND SKATE OR WATCH!** If you decide to skate, please pay Shiloh \$3.00 per adult. **Please pick up your child promptly at 12:00 pm at the Skatehouse (1508 N. Grand).** Students may bring their own roller blades if they have not been used outside. (Renting roller blades cost an additional \$3.00 and the students will pay this fee directly to the Skatehouse on Friday). *All students need to wear modest clothing (no stomachs showing when raising your hands above your head, no tanks tops, spaghetti straps, etc).* If inappropriate clothing is worn, the student will be asked to wear a large Shiloh t-shirt over his/her clothing. Any student who has not received a red card in the month of December will receive a free coke at the Skatehouse. Students may bring extra money for the concessions and games.
